This session will give an overview of project management and its importance in the success of a project. The phases of the PM lifecycle will be described, including the objective of each phase. We will also discuss the function of project controls and explain the elements involved. <p>3:15 pm – 4:15 pm</p>	<p>Project Spotlight – Tampa’s Westshore Interchange Reconstruction</p> <p>Courtney Drummond - <i>The Corradino Group</i> Zachary Stringer - <i>FDOT</i></p> <p>Tampa’s Westshore Interchange project is a billion-dollar investment by the Florida Department of Transportation and our local partners to reconnect neighborhoods, increase safety, and meet the mobility demands of our rapidly growing region. The Westshore project will rebuild the transportation network in the area where I-275, SR-60, Kennedy Boulevard, and other critical local routes come together in one of our region’s fastest growing communities. Key project highlights include investing in a \$16 billion regional economic engine with 4,000 businesses 102,000 employees, unlocking surrounding neighborhoods by connecting Reo, Occident, and Trask Streets, and increasing safety and reducing travel times by improving local streets and highways.
